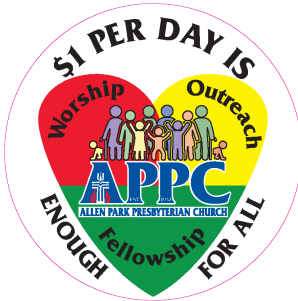

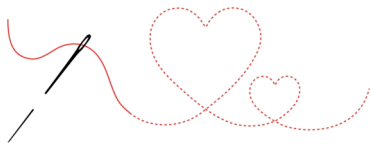
The Great Fabric and Sewing Notions Giveaway
