**Last month, we had a blast with 29 people.** Let's see if we can beat that record!

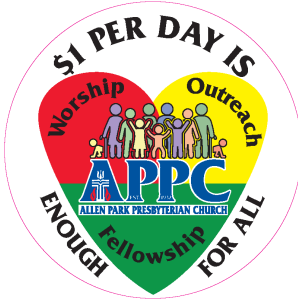
