Invite your friends and neighbors to come participate in this safe, family-friendly Halloween celebration.

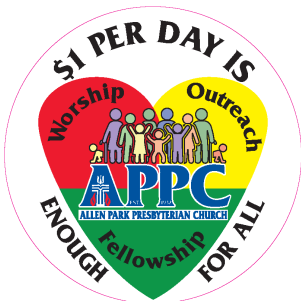
